3. Chairman's report

The Clerk had circulated a copy of the Annual Report for 2015-16. The Chair highlighted the following:

- a. There has been a full complement of Councillors during the year and a lot has been achieved in the village.
- b. Examples include progress on streetlight replacement, the imminent 40mph speed limit, defibrillator, Christmas celebrations, and playground/ open space maintenance.
- c. The Council took over responsibility for highway verge cutting in the village.
- d. The Council continues to monitor, liaise and raise representations with regard to major issues such as HS2, Station Bridge and the Airfield. These will continue to be major issues next year.
- e. The Council were active in raising representations on a large number of applications during the year, with a number of disappointing decisions being made by Selby DC. In order to increase local control in the future the Council has agreed to prepare a Neighbourhood Plan for Church Fenton.
- f. The new Cricket Pavilion was noted as a major new asset to the village.

4. Parish Issues

Concerns were raised about the condition of the pavements between the Play Park and White Horse.

It was noted that the oversized hedge along Church Street has now been cut.
