

RESULTS OF THE SHOP AND RECREATION AREA CONSULTATIONS

The Parish Council would like to thank local residents for responding to the recent consultations on the Village Shop and Main Street Recreation Ground. The results have been collated by the Parish Clerk and are summarised below. They will be considered further by the Parish Council at its next meeting on 23rd November.

Purchase of former Village Shop and Post Office

Support purchase – 151 (98.1%)

Do not support purchase – 3 (1.9%)

Concerns were expressed regarding the large financial commitment for the Council, and to ensure that any purchase was value for money.

Proposed All Weather Play facility – Main Street Play Area

Support provision – 118 (95.1%)

Object to provision – 3 (4.9%)

Concerns raised included location and the presence of an alternative facility at Ulleskelf. There were also comments about the height of fencing, location within the site, whether there would be a booking facility, and whether it could be made suitable for tennis. There was also a suggestion to add a small children's cycle/ scooter track to the site.
